Dear School #3 Parents:

So as to simplify the milk collection process for School #3 the district will continue to allow parents to pay for milk on a full-year or half-year basis. This approach eliminates the need to send cash on a monthly basis for your child's milk. The cost of milk continues to be 40 cents per 1/2 pint carton for the 2010-2011 school year. **Please note that the first day milk will be available is Tuesday, September 14<sup>th</sup>.**

Milk is not served on single session days, and the amount listed below for the full year payment is based on 173 days. Please note the collection process for the current school year as noted below:

**Please make all checks payable to Little Falls School #3 depending upon the building your child is attending. To assist with the process we ask that you staple/clip your check to the order form and forward it to your child's teacher in an envelope with their name printed on the outside.**
